

National Honor Patrol Criteria

The following eight focus areas make up the criteria to achieve National Honor Patrol status, and serve as the initial goal set for a Patrol and Patrol Leader on their development as a high functioning team.

Patrol Identity

- Patrol flag / totem
- Patrol cheer / yell
- Patrol symbol / totem
- Patrol Records up to date

Patrol Meetings

 Hold two Patrol Meetings per month

Patrol Advancement

 Help at least two Patrol members advance one rank

Patrol Uniforming

 At least 75% of all members of the Patrol wear the complete and proper uniform to Troop meetings and activities

Patrol Activities

Take part in at least one of the following as a Patrol:

- one hike
- one outdoor activity
- one Scouting event

Patrol Service

Complete Good Turn / Service
 Project as a Patrol

<u>Patrol Representation</u> Have at least one Patrol

Member (PL or APL) attend at least three PLC meetings

Patrol Recruiting & Retention

 Have a Patrol with eight members or experience an increase in Patrol Membership
